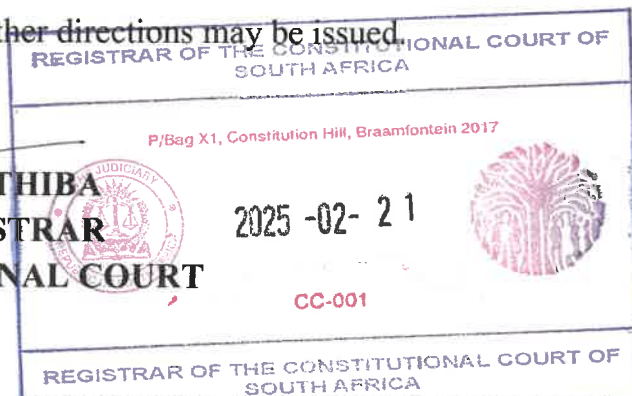
DIRECTIONS

The Chief Justice has issued the following directions:

1. This application, set down for hearing on 19 and 20 March 2025 is removed from the roll and set down for hearing on 21 and 22 May 2025.
2. The applicant must file—
 - (a) a truncated, indexed and paginated record containing all the documents set out in paragraph 3.1 of the applicant's letter addressed to this Court, dated 20 February 2025, by Friday, 28 February 2025; and
 - (b) an electronic, text-searchable, indexed and paginated record in PDF format, containing all the documents set out in paragraph 3.2 of the letter, on a USB flash drive, by Friday, 14 March 2025.
3. The volume numbers and pagination of the electronic record must follow sequentially from the truncated record.
4. Written submissions must be lodged by—
 - (a) the applicant, by Thursday, 20 March 2025; and
 - (b) all interested parties and *amici curiae*, by Friday, 28 March 2025.
5. Wasted costs occasioned by the removal of this application from the roll will stand over for determination at the hearing of the application.
